

The event begins at the Los Lunas Star Light Theater parking lot located at 2226 Sun Ranch Village Loop SW, Los Lunas, NM 87031. This spacious area allows the runners and spectators a spectacular view of both the El Cerro de Los Lunas and Manzano mountains. The courses are controlled by police, military and civilian volunteers.

COURSE INFORMATION

10k Course - 7:30 am

The total elevation gain is 141 ft. to the highest point above Los Lunas. The course circulates through the Huning Ranch neighborhood, then back East ending at the Star Light Theater.

5k Course - 8:30 am

The total elevation gain is 85 ft. The course loops through the Huning Ranch neighborhood. This is a fast course finishing back at the Star Light Theater. Rucksack participants will run/walk with a backpack weighing a minimum of 35 lbs.

Kids K - 9:30 am

This fun children's event takes place right in front of the Starlight Theater.
