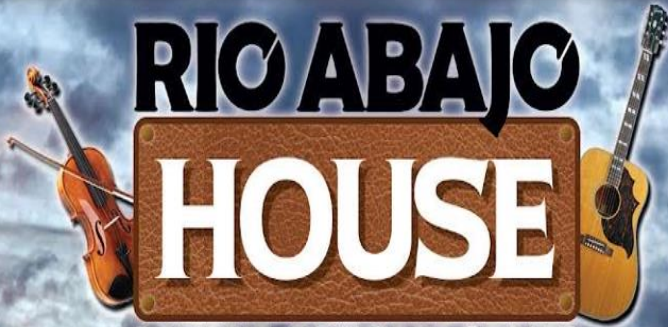

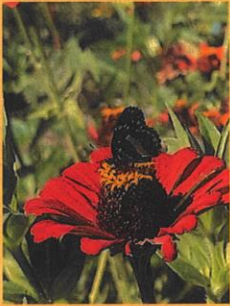

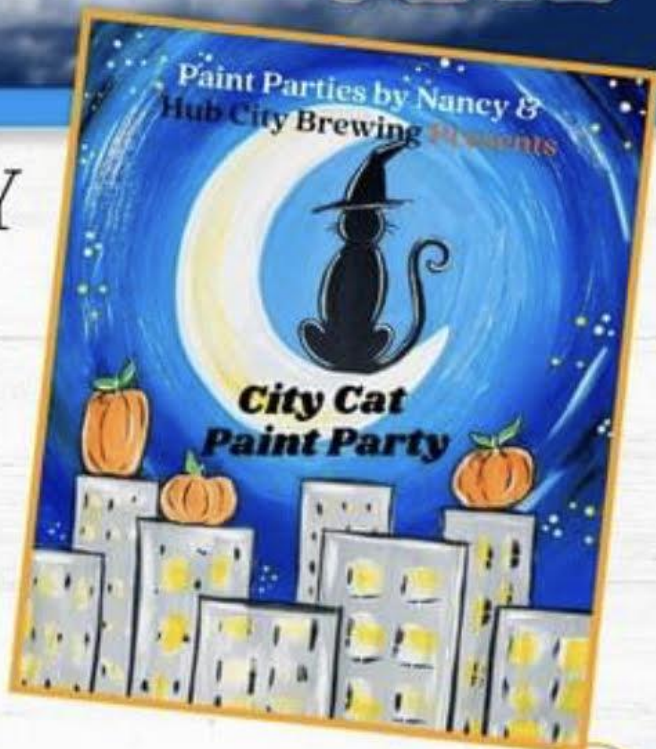

Have you always wanted to write your family history, or start a podcast, but don’t know how to ask the right questions? This workshop invites participants to explore a range of interview techniques including: How to interview family members for oral history projects, how to interview community members and leaders for community studies, how to interview people for writing, radio, social media and film. We will listen, watch and practice with various interview techniques. Learn what makes a "bad" interviewer, a good interview, how to be an active listener through conversational interviewing.
